# **News from the Village Shop:**

The funds received from easyfundraising have enabled us to purchase a large display fridge which has been needed for some time. We can now stock a wider range of fruit and vegetables, including fresh strawberries grown on Ercall Heath, plus fresh meats and savouries from the organically-run Fordhall Farm near Market Drayton.

These items are proving popular, especially the strawberries and Fordhall's sausage rolls. We also have two sizes and four flavours of Fordhall's frozen meat-filled pies in the Shop which can be cooked from frozen in 1 hour.

We thank everyone who has registered with easyfundraising and encourage others to please join. Registering is free and all money raised goes to the Shop, so ultimately back into the Community. There is also a 1515 bus during school terms from Burton Borough School to Tibberton. Note that all buses are available to any passengers. Buses take approximately 15 minutes in either direction. Buses from Newport to Tibberton continue on to Wellington (except the1515) which takes around an hour. Similarly, buses from Tibberton to Newport originate from Wellington about an hour earlier. **USE IT OR LOSE IT!**
