Defibrillator

You may know that a week or so ago there was an emergency on the Playing Field – a footballer suffered a suspected cardiac arrest. Someone went to the shop to get the defibrillator, but couldn't open the box to get at it, and couldn't find any phone numbers to try. If you are in this position, the defib box is unlocked and will open, but it does need a really good pull on the door. A list of trained villagers is contained in the box. There is also a stab kit available to the left of the shop door in case of emergencies
