Perhaps you play in a band or an orchestra which is planning a tour, or you are interested in learning to play the clarinet but you don't have an instrument. Maybe you play in a sports team and you need to buy some kit or equipment. The Tibberton Trust Fund may be able to help you. Grants can be made to young people who are in need of financial assistance to enable them to continue with their education or to prepare themselves for a career, to support their physical and educational needs, or to enhance their individual development through participation in extracurricular opportunities. Applicants should be under 25 and should be resident or have a parent who is resident in the Parish of Tibberton, or should attend or have attended Tibberton School. Only one application can be made by an applicant within a 12 month period. This fund was set up for the benefit of the young people in this village and the Trustees would welcome more applications for consideration. The Trustees meet twice a year and the next meeting will be held on 15th May 2025.
